Preliminary Annual Crash Report: December 31, 2018

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Abstract

This report provides an analysis of traffic crashes that occurred as at December 31, 2018. The traffic crash data quoted met fundamental guidelines for reporting and classifying traffic crashes as defined by the Road Safety Unit. The main criteria are; the crash has been reported to the police, the crash occurred on a road open to and used by the public, whether the road is public or private and the crash involved a vehicle, which, at the time of the crash was in motion.

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PREFACE

DRIVERS URGED TO CUT SPEED THIS CHRISTMAS

December 31, 2018 – The Road Safety Unit is appealing to motorists to reduce their speed on the nation’s roads as the Yuletide season approaches. This appeal comes in light of the 383 being persons killed since January, and 40 persons dying in 31 days so far this month.

Director, Road Safety Unit, Kenute says as the Christmas season approaches, persons, particularly motorists and pedestrians should exercise greater care on the roads. “We are appealing to drivers to cut their speed and look out for vulnerable road users, never overtake on a bend or at a junction or unnecessarily; never drive in a manner that will prove offensive to other road users. In addition, always use their seatbelts, ensure passengers in the vehicle utilize them as well as, and children are securely fastened in the correct protective devices.”

Of the 383 deaths from 340 fatal crashes, motorcyclists, pedestrians, passenger in private motor vehicles, and drivers of private motor vehicles account for 80% of road users killed to date.

Statistics from the Unit also highlight that males deaths continue to outnumber female deaths on the nation’s roads, of the 383, 332 were males and 51 were females. Mr. Hare added that the Country did not meet the target of below 300 and there is projected to be an increase which is worrying, as motorcyclists and pedestrians continue to be the leading categories of road users being killed. Hence they need to be extra cautious in the traffic environment. “In order to have a peaceful Christmas season, road users must obey the rules of the road at all times. We cannot afford to lose anyone else in 2018, slow down and save lives. Remember to drive for the Family.”

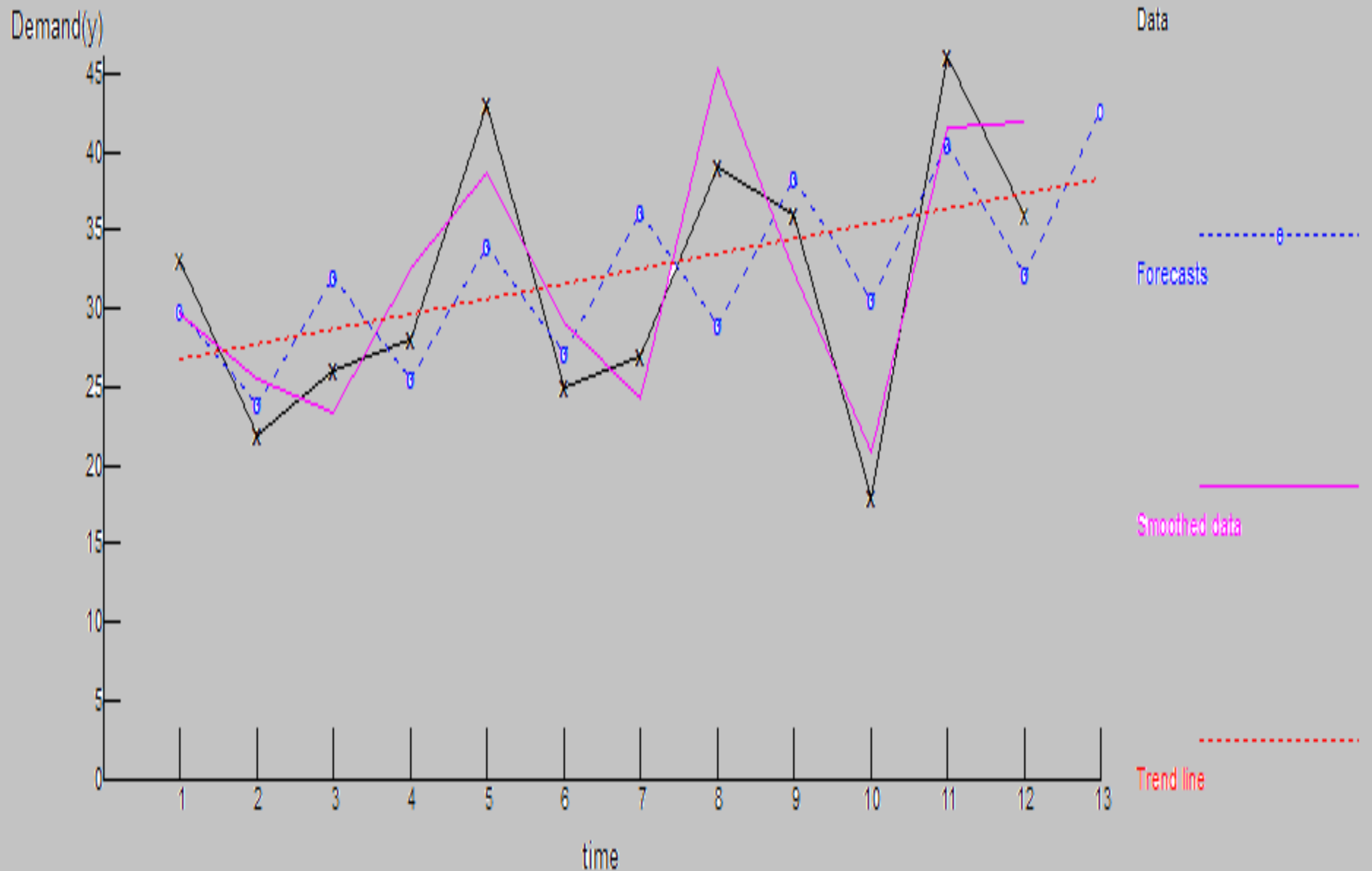
SUMMARY

- Three hundred and eighty-three (383) persons have been killed in three hundred and forty (340) fatal crashes since the start of the year.
- Fatal crashes and fatalities have increased by sixteen per cent (16%) and nineteen per cent (19%) respectively when compared with similar period in 2017.
- Fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by sixteen per cent (16%) when compared with 2017.
- Child fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by eleven per cent (11%) when compared with 2017.
- Elderly fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by nineteen per cent (19%) when compared with 2017.
- Pedestrian fatalities for 2018 are projected to decrease by seven per cent (7%) when compared with 2017.
- Private motor vehicle passenger fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by forty-nine per cent (49%) when compared with 2017.
- Private motor vehicle driver fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by fifteen per cent (15%) when compared with 2017.
- Motorcyclist fatalities for 2018 are projected to decrease by five per cent (5%) when compared with 2017.
- Pedal cyclist fatalities for 2018 are projected to increase by sixty per cent (60%) when compared with 2017.
- Pedestrians account for twenty-two per cent (22%) of the road users killed since the start of the year.
- PMC Drivers account for eighteen per cent (18%) of the road users killed since the start of the year.
- PMC Passengers account for fifteen per cent (15%) of road users killed since the start of the year.
- Motorcyclists account for twenty-six per cent (26%) of the road users killed since the start of the year.
- Vulnerable road users (Pedestrian, Pedalcyclist, Motorcyclist and Pillion) account for fifty-eight per cent (58%) of road users killed since the start of the year.
- Passengers account for twenty-three per cent (23%) of the road users killed since the start of the year.
- Males and females account for eighty-seven per cent (87%) and thirteen per cent (13%) respectively of the persons killed in traffic crashes.
- St. Catherine account for twenty per cent (20%) of the overall fatalities since the start of the year.
- St. Catherine, St. Andrew and Westmoreland account for forty-four per cent (44%) of the overall fatalities since the start of the year.
- Area 1 (Trelawny, St. James, Hanover and Westmoreland), Area 2 (St. Ann, St. Mary and Portland), Area 3 (Clarendon, Manchester and St. Elizabeth), Area 4 (St. Andrew Central, St. Andrew South, Kingston Eastern, Kingston Central and Kingston Western), Area 5 (St. Andrew North,

St. Catherine North, St. Catherine South and St. Thomas) accounts for thirty per cent (30%), fifteen per cent (15%), eighteen per cent (18%), twelve per cent (12%) and twenty-five per cent (25%) respectively of the overall road fatalities.

- Twenty-one children died from seventeen traffic crashes since the start of the year.
- Child fatalities have increased by eleven per cent (11%) when compared to similar period in 2017.
- Thirty-three per cent (33%) of the children killed in traffic crashes were pmc passengers.
- Forty-seven elderly persons lost their lives in forty-seven fatal crashes since the start of this year.
- Elderly fatalities have increased by twelve (12%) when compared with similar period in 2017.
- Forty-five per cent (45%) of the elderly persons killed in traffic crashes were pedestrians.
- Eighty-three pedestrians have died as a result of eighty-two fatal pedestrian crashes since the start of the year.
- Pedestrian fatalities have decreased by three per cent (3%) when compared with similar period in 2017.
- St. Catherine, St. Ann and St. Andrew account for forty-seven per cent (47%) of the pedestrian fatalities since the start of the year.
- Males and females account for eighty-six per cent (86%) and fourteen per cent (14%) respectively of the pedestrian fatalities.
- Fifty-six private motor vehicle passengers have been killed in forty-six fatal crashes since the start of the year.
- Private motor vehicle passenger fatalities have increased by sixty per cent (60%) when compared with similar period in 2017.
- St. James, St. Ann and St. Catherine account for fifty per cent (50%) of the private motor vehicle passenger fatalities since the start of the year.
- Seventy private motor vehicle drivers have been killed in seventy fatal crashes since the start of this year.
- Private motor vehicle driver fatalities have increased by thirty-two per cent (32%) when compared with similar period in 2017.
- Males account for ninety per cent (90%) and females account for ten per cent (10%) of the private motor vehicle driver fatalities since the start of the year.
- Ninety-nine motorcyclists have been killed in ninety-six fatal crashes since the start of the year.
- Motorcyclist fatalities have increased by two per cent (2%) when compared with similar period in 2017.
- Westmoreland, St. Elizabeth and St. Andrew account for fifty-two per cent (52%) of the motorcyclists that were killed since the start of the year.
- Males account for all of the motorcyclist fatalities since the start of the year.
- Six multiple fatal collisions occurred since the start of the year resulting in twenty-three road fatalities.
- Twenty-four pedal cyclists have been killed in twenty-three traffic crashes since the start of the year.
